Filing your taxes and your FAFSA? Bring items from both lists!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Proof of identification – Picture ID <input type="checkbox"/> Social Security Cards for you, your spouse and dependents or a Social Security Number verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration <input type="checkbox"/> Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return <input type="checkbox"/> Wage and earning statement(s) Forms W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc from ALL employers for you and your spouse <input type="checkbox"/> Interest and dividend statements (Forms 1099) <input type="checkbox"/> A copy of last year's tax returns if available <input type="checkbox"/> Proof of bank account routing numbers and account numbers for Direct Deposit, such as a blank check <input type="checkbox"/> Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number <input type="checkbox"/> To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms. <input type="checkbox"/> Records of student loan payments <input type="checkbox"/> Records of payments for educational expenses, such as college tuition <input type="checkbox"/> Records of union dues and initiation fees, if you paid any during 2011 <input type="checkbox"/> Mortgage interest and property tax statements if you own your home <input type="checkbox"/> Your six-digit Identity Protection PIN (IPPIN) - if the IRS issued one to you or your spouse 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Your Social Security card <input type="checkbox"/> Your driver's license (if any) <input type="checkbox"/> Your 2011 W-2 forms and other records of money earned <input type="checkbox"/> Your (and if married, your spouse's) 2011 Federal Income Tax Return—not necessary if you are preparing your return with CAMP/FAST during the same appointment <input type="checkbox"/> Your Parents' 2011 Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student)—not necessary if you are preparing your return with CAMP/FAST during the same appointment <input type="checkbox"/> Your 2011 untaxed income records <input type="checkbox"/> Your current bank statements <input type="checkbox"/> Your current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond and other investment records <input type="checkbox"/> Your alien registration or permanent resident card (if you are not a U.S. citizen) <input type="checkbox"/> Name of the schools that you (or your child) are applying to <input type="checkbox"/> Your student and parent FAFSA PIN if you want to file electronically (Students and parents have separate PINs)
